Boarding Contract

Self Care Board

High Standard Stables will provide hay, shavings, and up to 6 quarts of grain daily, is included with board. The boarder will provide their own grain for their horse if they do not like what is offered by High Standard Stables. If the horse has any supplements High Standard Stables will be happy to feed them but it is the owner's responsibility to supply them. The horse being boarded will follow High Standard Stables worming schedule. High Standard Stables will buy and give the horse the wormer, then will add the wormer to the monthly bill. If you have your own wormer you can give it to Amy and she will give it to your horse on the same day as all the others.

High Standard Stables will be happy to feed and turnout your horse everyday but it is your responsibility to clean their stall, make sure they have hay, water, and bring them in everyday. If you can't come up to take care of your horse you will be charged an extra \$2.50/day. Please let Amy know by that morning if you can't come up that evening. In return for feeding and turnout you will be responsible for doing chores at HSS once a week (if you miss your chore day and do not make it up that week you will owe an extra \$15/chore day missed). The chores will include: cleaning all stalls to the standard of Amy, throwing down hay and putting hay in stalls, sweeping the aisle, dumping grain in buckets, dumping, scrubbing, and filling all water buckets, and bringing in all horses. Chores should take about 2 hours. If Chores are not done well you could lose the opportunity to do the chore day for the reduced board rate.

The bill must be paid the 1st of the month for that month's board. Any bill that is not received by the 15th of the month will have a \$10 late fee added. If payment is delayed beyond 30 days a 10% late fee compounded monthly will apply. If the owner neglects to pay the bill in 90 days, High Standard Stables retains the right to sell the horse to get the money needed to pay the bill.

The boarder must take a lesson per week from Amy while they board at High Standard Stables. Each boarder will get a special rate which is the winter package rate. They will receive this rate all year long while they are boarding at High Standard Stables. The lessons are not included in the board and must be paid for separately.

The owner is responsible for all vet and farrier charges. You may use our farrier/vet or use your own. You are responsible for setting up the appointments and being there to hold your horse. If you can't be there to hold your horse there will be holding fees. Please see attached sheet for additional charges.

Any additional charges for extra service, supplies, wormer, etc.. will be added to bill.

The horse stabled at High Standard Stables must have rabies from current year, and coggins from current year or year before. Also required is a 5-way, 4 way, or 3 way, and rhino, and west nile. I need to receive a copy of the coggins, rabies certificate, and shot record before the horse is allowed on premise.

High Standard Stables retains the right to void the contract at anytime and can ask the boarder to leave.

If at any time the boarder wishes to leave HSS a one month written notice must be given so that the spot may be filled when you leave.

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The rate for 1 month board is: \$205.00 per month plus 8% tax. **Total due: \$221.40** per month

I will not hold High Standard Stable liable for any injuries or damages done to the myself, or any other person that attends the barn with me, my horse, tack, or any other item that may be kept at High Standard Stables. In the case the horse is seriously injured or has to be put down I will not hold High Standard Stables liable or at fault.

2012 Barn Rules

- Feel free to turn on lights but make sure to turn them off when you are done
- If your horse goes to the bathroom in the aisle or ring or on the way to the ring please make sure to pick it up before you leave.
- If a gate/door is closed make sure to keep it closed if it is open leave it open.
- No running or screaming while in the barn
- Do not go in the pasture unless you have permission or have your own horse
- When getting your horse from the pasture please be careful not to let other horses out...if they do get out or you need help for any reason please call me (585) 905-9955
- Only the students are allowed in stall to get their horse ready not anyone else.
- Please remove the halter if the horse is out in pasture or in stall.
- Wear appropriate clothing when in the barn. No shoes that are not covered.
- Do not feed the horses unless you have permission including treats!
- Make sure to close stall doors even when you leave for just a second.
- No one is allowed to drive or operate any tractor, gator, or lawnmower at anytime without written permission.
- Last one out of the barn – turn out all lights, make sure tack room door is shut, all stalls are latched, and close front and back doors of barn.

Thanks for your Cooperation these rules are for your safety and the horses

Riding Rules While Amy is teaching a lesson:

- Rider that is in a lesson has the right of way on the rail! It is the responsibility of the other riders to stay out of their way!!
- If Amy is teaching a jumping lesson no one else is allowed to jump during that time.
- If the lesson is not jumping and you wish to jump after asking Amy's permission if it is okay you may jump 1 outside line but please no courses so that you do not get in the lesson students way.
- You must control your horses speed there will be no cantering out of control and running up behind other horses especially my student that is in a lesson!
- So to sum it up Student in lesson gets right of way and you must not disrupt their lesson in any way.
- If a student is in a private lesson there will be a limit to 4 other riders in the ring at the most!!!

These rules are for the safety of riders and especially so that the lesson student gets as much as possible from the lesson! Please respect these rules or you may be asked to ride in the dressage ring or wait to ride when the lesson is finished.

Rules while riding at HSS

- If your horse goes to the bathroom in the aisle or ring please make sure to pick it up before you leave.
- No chewing gum when riding.
- **When riding wear long pants, boots with heel, and HELMET.**
- When riding Please stay in the outdoor ring, dressage ring, or roundpen. Please do not go in fields or on cross country course unless you are in a lesson.
- If you want to go for a trail ride please be in a group and let Amy know where you are going, and NO jumping or going over any xc jumps without being in a lesson.
- No Jumping unless you are in a lesson or Amy is Supervising!!
